

Coming Soon: Seacroft, Leeds LS14

Leeds City Council are delighted to offer 33 new council homes in Seacroft, located on the corner of Brooklands Avenue & Seacroft Crescent. There will be a mixture of 1, 2 and 3 bedroom properties.

Advertising of these homes is due to start in late spring, early summer.



The New Build Lettings Policy will apply to these homes which means, preference will be given to applicants in the following order:

1. Leeds City Council tenants living in the Killingbeck & Seacroft ward
2. Local Connection to the ward area by means of living in, working in, attending education in, or having close family living in the ward
3. All other applicants

50% of the properties will be shortlisted in order of housing need & 50% of the properties will be shortlisted in date of registration order on the housing register.

All applicants will need to demonstrate an excellent tenancy record. We will consider an applicant's rent payment history, issues of anti-social behaviour and overall tenancy record. References will be requested from Housing Associations or Private Landlords (5 years history will be considered).



All these homes are wheelchair accessible therefore suitable for families, older people and applicants who are disabled.
